RESOLUTIONS TO BE PROPOSED AT THE
DREYFUS DEMONSTRATION
HYDE PARK, SUNDAY AFTERNOON 3: 30.

RESOLUTION NO. 1.

That this mass meeting of the citizens of London assembled in Hyde Park sends the expression of its deepest sympathy to Captain and Madame Dreyfus and assures them that wherever the English tongue is spoken there is admiration and gratitude for the splendid courage and noble example they have shown amidst unparalleled persecution.

RESOLUTION NO. 2

That this meeting expresses its abhorrence of men who have sullied the honour of the uniform they wear in their long and desperate fight with Truth and Innocence; congratulates Zola, Picquart, Labori, Demange, and their supporters for the splendid resistance they have made to military and sectarian fanaticism, and appeals to the Government of the Republic to act according to the best traditions of free and generous France by releasing and rehabilitating Captain Dreyfus before it is too late.
