19 The relation which exists between you, parent and your children is truly important. There is not, perhaps, a more important relation among all the created beings God has made. The all-wise Creator has formed this relation by a divine constitution and ordinance [the whole constitution of the world and existence of mankind] which have for their object the care of the whole human race from the first child to the last generation which will be born.

God has seen fit to make man the agent for bringing men into existence. The subjects of the most government of God, in this world are the appointed instruments of bringing more subjects into existence."
