what you have committed your child to. If the school rules are circulated to parents, read them carefully. Don't sign in blanket resignation; send them back with comments. Find out who is responsible for caning, keep your eye open for any enthusiastic amateurs.

It has never been established whether a parent's explicitly expressed objections to institutional corporal punishment are legally viable. STOPP (see below) issue yellow forms on which parents who do not wish corporal punishment to be inflicted on their children can register their claim for exemption. These forms simply withdraw delegation of the parental privilege of child-beating. This procedure will not cover the likelihood of your child being beaten, but in practice it will usually help end the issue.

All STOPP hopes to do through the scheme is to clear the mists of uncertainty enveloping the whole parent/teacher relationship. The move is a provocative one. Perhaps, in such a strange situation, it is needed?

There are two pressure groups at work to end corporal punishment: STOPP (Society of Teachers Opposed to Physical Punishment), 12 Lawn Road, London N.W.3, organise meetings, send out speakers, and give advice to parents and teachers.

DOVE (Delegation Opposing Violent Education), Sandwell Manor, Totnes, Devon, tend to enlarge the issue into a broad personal critique of society.

The best discussion of corporal punishment in boarding schools is to be found in Royston Lambert's *The Hothouse Society* (published by Weidenfeld and Nicolson). The most acute look at State schools is that taken by Peter Newell in *A Last Resort?* (Penguin). The legal situation can be usefully checked in G. R. Barrell's *The Teacher and the Law* (Methuen).

The cane shop

Eric Huntingdon says selling canes is a social service. Since he opened up his market in 1966 "the demand has been enormous.

"We've had thousands of orders from everywhere, parents of course, but also schools, Heads and individual teachers. People feel things have gone too far. You see police armed with just a pair of handcuffs and a truncheon, going in to tackle vicious young school kids. The police are wonderful. I couldn't do the job. People are frightened these days, there's no doubt about it. We've had letters, hundreds of them since we started. People with enough degrees to sink a battleship write in. Professional people, doctors, clergy, welfare workers, you name them. At our busiest we were supplying 50 to 100 canes a week.

"All *bona fide* types. You do get the cranks, of course, but you can usually spot them. The caning issue is worrying a lot of people. Certainly before we came along and filled the gap parents were driven to punishing with all sorts of stuff - hose pipes, garden canes, leather boots. One lady, a

very charming person, told us she'd had a perfectly awful time with her eight-year-old daughter - a very difficult child, just dug her heels in and said no. You know the type. She said she'd practically taken the skin off the child's bottom with a riding whip trying to control her. It was a relief for her to find somewhere that sold the proper tool for the job.

"We give guidance about how to use a cane to all buyers. We're always being asked: 'How many strokes?' I usually suggest 'six of the best' in most cases, but we do emphasise that children shouldn't be beaten for trivial offences. Some parents go about it in the wrong way. They'll send a child to buy a cane. I really don't agree with that. It's best to have an organised system. One cane on show in the home and one in the cupboard for use.

"I don't agree with hitting children frequently, they get used to it, like you get used to toothache. I mean it was more or less proved in the war that individual levels of pain tolerance vary enormously. No, continual walloping has no effect. It's best to use a cane rarely, but when you do, have a bit of ceremony about it. Now I don't mean dad and mum parading into the living room with a cane on a cushion. I mean a proper approach. Never hit a child in anger, and always beat the backside, not the hand. I do emphasise, though, that even a child is entitled to modesty. We don't advocate caning on bare flesh. I also don't approve of fathers beating girls. It should be mothers and daughters, fathers and sons. Our canes may look small, but by God they sting!"
