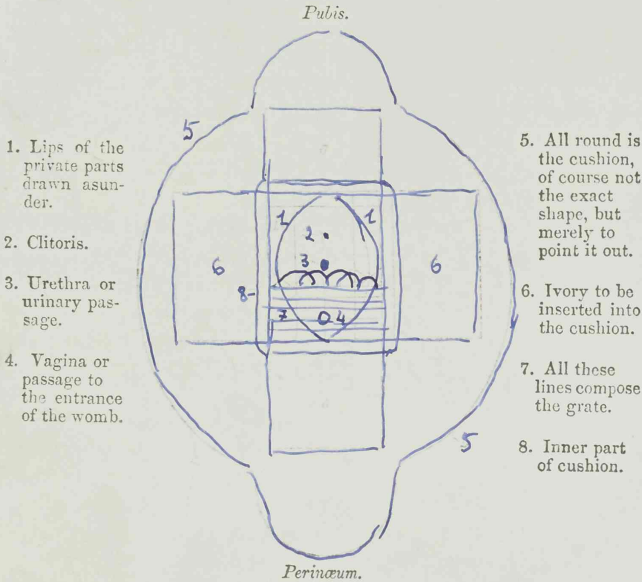

A ROUGH SKETCH OF THE GRATING AND CUSHION.



- 1. Lips of the private parts drawn asunder.
- 2. Clitoris.
- 3. Urethra or urinary passage.
- 4. Vagina or passage to the entrance of the womb.

- 5. All round is the cushion, of course not the exact shape, but merely to point it out.
- 6. Ivory to be inserted into the cushion.
- 7. All these lines compose the grate.
- 8. Inner part of cushion.

The principal object of this apparatus is to keep out every Object of this thing—the fingers, candles, artificial and natural generative apparatus. organs, so that they cannot be put into the vagina or passage leading into the womb, to cause pleasurable sensations by friction.

It is to be made to be kept clear of the urinary passage, and Objects to be to allow of the free flow of urine. It must also be made that it avoided in may be prevented from shifting out of its place; and at the making the apparatus. same time it must be simple in its application, so that it may be easily put on; and at the same time it must be difficult of being taken off by those upon whom it may be—we should say impossible to be taken off by them. It must also be made, and so fitted on, that it must not impede the movements of the limbs, or hurt any of the privy parts. It is to be made of material to
