S. is the state which regards itself as solely responsible for the well being of the community and therefore provides a certain amount of guidance and management in the struggle to achieve that well being, intervening to this end in various fields of social affairs: coll. The Welfare state from the Christian point of view.

" The distinguishing characteristic of the W. S. is the assumption by the community acting through the state, of the responsibility for providing the means whereby all its members can reach minimum standards of health, economic security and civilized living, and can share according to their capacity in its social and cultural heritage "
