Monsieur le Ministre,

Permit me to offer you a copy of another little historical tract which I have printed rather hurriedly. The narrative itself affords a very striking picture of the turbulence of Ireland at the beginning of the fourteenth century.

The Secretary of the London Library has requested me to forward to you the enclosed copy of their Catalogue. He has written to the Minister of Public Instruction to beg a copy of the historical publications of the French government for the library, and I forwarded the letter to M. Villuminé two or three days ago. The London Library is a substantial and respectable foundation, in which I believe that Mr Mallam (who is now in Germany) and Mr Milne have taken a good deal of interest.

I am waiting for their being posted off to send you a copy of a paper I recently read before our Society of Antiquaries on the Political Condition of the English peasantry during the Middle Ages, in which I have collected a few materials which had not previously been used. My first idea was taken from reading one of the chapters in your history of Civilization in France.
