Then one Sunday I had sensations all day long. After  
dinner last down as nearly mad, so I went to my room,  
took a clean sheet of white paper, and fringed myself  
over it. My pen only slightly unsteady, I fringed  
smooth, and then as the paper lay before me covered  
with wavy-ripples I cried because it was not up my  
dear Sarah's angle, laid up head on the table where  
the paper lay, and sobbed with sobs, jealousy, and  
repents, for I thought some one would take her if I  
did not, that it would be her hateful husband whom she  
had helped to keep with my money.

I saw my love that on several occasions of my life  
I have fringed myself over a clean sheet of foolscap  
paper; it was mostly done for curiosity, to see what  
my name was like, whether it was as thin, or as thick,  
or as large in quantity as at the last time I previously  
had mentioned.

The interesting shift, I think, is from the more acute  
bringing together of masturbation, writing, jealousy,  
jealousy of the husband and money (the subject is a woman  
who has great quantities of money, as well as power, to  
spend on me) in the first paragraph to the more  
dramatized, British-empirical "curiosity" in the second.


