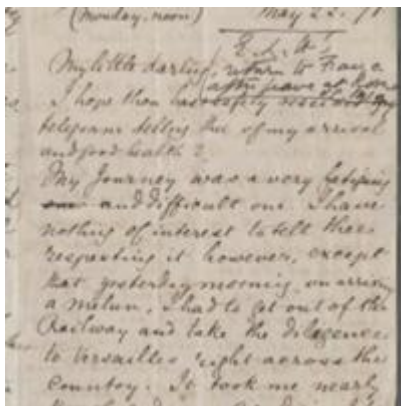

I drove up to Meudon yesterday, afternoon, a place where one has a view of Paris very similar to the view of Rome from the Villa Mellani. The distance is about the same, and you in Paris could not believe you just as we saw Rome to Italy. All the chief monuments are perfectly distinct, the gilded dome of the Invalides, the Pantheon, the Palais de l'Industrie, the Nouvel Opéra &c. The ramparts surrounding Paris just as the walls do Rome, are also perfectly conspicuous and the breach through which the Prussians broke passed. All the houses immediately within the ramparts are reduced to a state of ruin impossible to describe, as I could see with the naked eye.

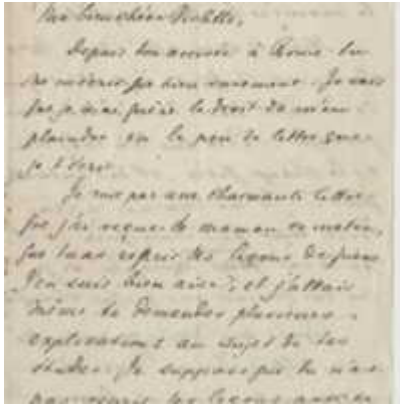
